## **Chapter 7: Spanish Louisiana**

## **Summary:**

Students will create a web-based Padlet board to share research about a topic from the chapter.

**Duration:** 60-90 minutes

#### Notes:

- The Padlet site may be useful throughout the year as a platform to share research. This lesson can serve as an introduction to the online tool.
- Students may create an account to use Padlet, but it's optional. An account requires an email address, however. There are some strategies for accomplishing this. - You may want to show students the <u>sample Padlet board</u> in order to give them an idea of what they are creating.
- Allow students to choose from any of the people, places, or topics in the chapter. There
  are quite a few, and this will allow students to gain some depth of knowledge about one
  of them. This is certainly a project that could be accomplished by a pair of students
  working together. One computer could be used for the Padlet board, the other for
  research.
- An option is to have students email their final Padlet board to the teacher. Then, using a
  projection system, show the completed Padlet to the class and have them present their
  information in a brief presentation.

### **Answer Key:**

The final Padlet board should have all the information required from the data table on the Padlet board.
