2. _____ Civil War is the conflict between the North and the South, fought from 1861 to 1865; it resulted in the end of slavery in the United States
3. _____ of Confederation was the first plan of government for the United States, adopted in 1781; it was not very effective and was replaced by the US Constitution in 1787
4. a system that prevents any of the three branches of US government from dominating the other branches; it helps ensure that no single person or group will be able to violate the rights of other Americans
5. a struggle, mainly during the 1960s, when activists fought against unjust treatment that excluded African Americans from voting, left them vulnerable to violence, and ignored their economic and educational needs
6. the legislative branch of the US government; it consists of the Senate and the House of Representatives
7. United States _____ is one of the founding documents of the United States, written in 1787; it set up our nation's framework for government
8. a form of government where citizens have the power in choosing their leader
9. the US government agency, founded in the early 1970s, that monitors the environment and makes sure people and companies are following laws designed to keep the country clean
10. a category of people grouped together because they have a common ancestry, language, or culture
11. _____ Amendment is the amendment to the US Constitution that ensures freedom of religion, speech, the press, assembly, and petition; part of the Bill of Rights

16. the building outside Washington, DC, that is headquarters of the US Department of Defense; it was damaged during the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks
