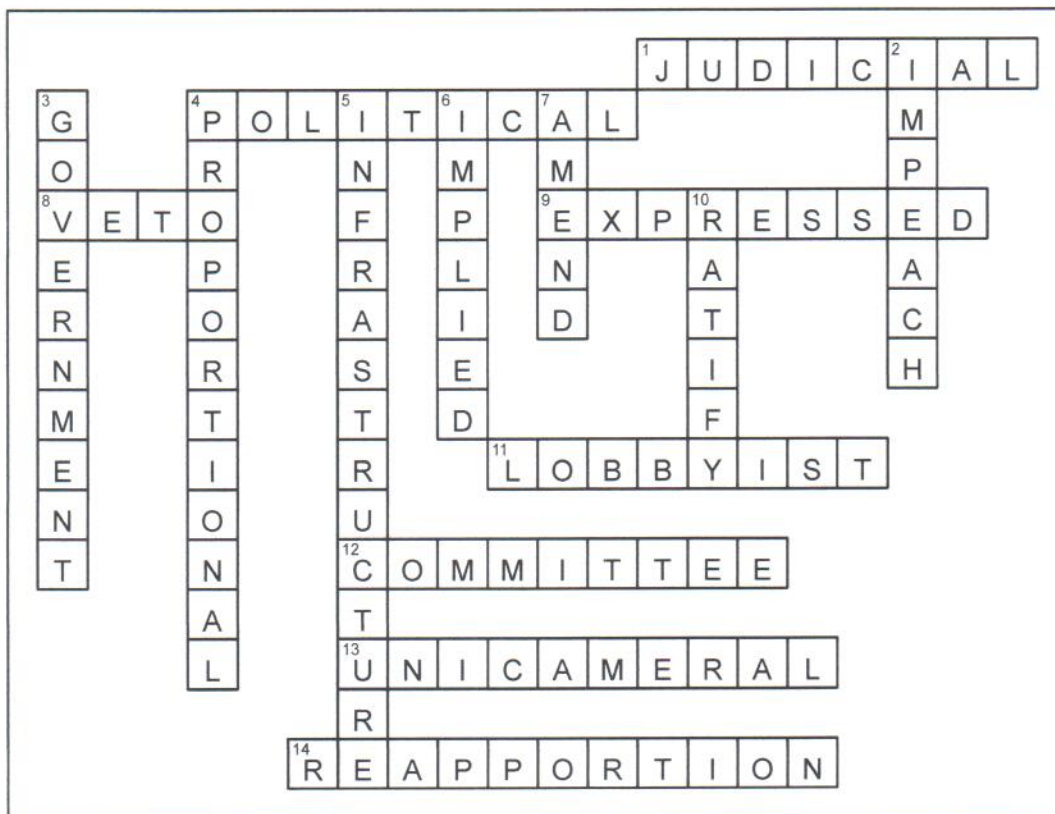


## Ch 1 Puzzle 2 American Government-Citizenship
